





Idea incubator/accelerator to overcome persistent barriers to health equity

 7 prototypes to be finalized and tested on a small scale by volunteer countries.

- KLIC Challenges

Monitoring, evaluation, accountability & learning

- Establish regular processes to assess the impact of KLIC activities
- Collect information and evidence

Capacity Building of KLIC Members

- Training of the KLIC community in innovative approaches: design thinking, agile management, data science, innovation strategy, etc.
- Virtual innovation agora for knowledge sharing
- Knowledge sharing tools and collaborative platform, database of proven innovations.
- Exchange trip on innovation in public health.
- KLIC2025: Hanoi → Cotonou → Siem Reap (Cambodia)

Communication and advocacy

- Knowledge translation, publication of case studies, technical notes, report on the impact of KLIC activities
- Organize public health innovation forums for decision-makers and public authorities from low- and middle-income countries.
